Key Responsibilities

The Civils Inspector will have daily communications with Gigaclear's Project Managers and is responsible for H&S and build Quality of Gigaclear's Ultrafast Fibre Network.

- Conduct site safety checks to ensure all subcontractor signing and guarding and traffic management in general is appropriate and as per NRSWA spec.
- Instruct contractor crews on appropriate signing and guarding as necessary.
- Complete joint site inspection to assess visual quality of civils work.
- Conduct compaction tests as per specification to gauge the absolute level of compaction.
- Coach crews on appropriate civils methods to ensure that build quality is maintained.
- Ensure all civils work is as per all relevant HAUC standards.
- Oversee core test regime and document findings with recommendations as required.
- Liaise with local communities to ensure build programme progresses smoothly and with minimum disruption.
- Conduct site surveys to assist initial design process.
- Ensure construction phase plans and Health and Safety files in place and being adhered to.
- Assist Project Manager to walk routes with subcontractor to ensure work is competed to the correct standard.
